 Raptor System Cost and Fundraising. A request has been received for the \$6400 Raptor System that will be used to check-in all persons entering the schools during school hours and alert staff of any unapproved visitors. This includes volunteers, family visitors, vendors and contractors. The system can be used for all background checks. Currently the school pays \$17 a background check but will cost only \$5 for a three year check. This will eliminate any social security information required for a background check to be filtered through the schools. The system will be used to coordinate daily and event volunteers.

Motion to pay up to \$6400 for the Raptor System was made and will be voted on by eligible members at the December 10th meeting. Mr. Johnston and Dr. Ramsdell is getting us exact amount for our portion.
